

Conference Openings – 2018 Slate [6-14-18 AG FINAL]

CONFERENCE COUNCIL – NCNC priority and policy setter; provides mission-based leadership and strategic governance; manages the Conference’s physical and financial assets and acts as the Conference between Annual Gatherings. Commitment is for a four-year term, about nine meetings per year, plus active participation on Council Sub-Committees and some communication between meetings. The Moderator and Vice-Moderator of the Conference are voting members of the Council. Each Association elects two members of the Council; eight members-at-large are elected by the Annual Meeting, at least four of whom must be under the age of 30 when elected. Associate Members have voice without vote on the Council.
