

Reverend Diane Lynn Weible grew up in St. Louis Missouri, attended Drury College in Springfield, Missouri, and Eden Theological Seminary in St. Louis. She was ordained by the St. Louis Association of the former Missouri Conference of the United Church of Christ in May 1991. Diane served as a missionary in Japan for 12 years.

In 2004 Diane and her family moved to Hawaii where she became the Associate Pastor at Kailua Christian Church (UCC). Two years later Diane became the Minister of Communication of the Hawaii Conference of the UCC. From 2008 to 2015 she served as the Associate Conference Minister in Hawaii.
