AG 7 Report: Jeannie Hobson

The theme is "The Elephant Within" and the scripture is Isaiah 65 V 17-18. It will be held June 15th – June 17th,2023 at a location yet to be determined. Several options are being explored. The Business Committee will be completed after Thanksgiving.

Transition Update & Conference Minister Report: Diane Weible

We have 26 Authorized Ministers who have not completed their Lifelong Learning Report, which has to be done by January 31st. And 26+ are none in compliance with their mandated reporting. Those receiving the letter informing them of these will have 6 months to come into compliance or have their standing suspended. Racial Justice training is needed by 105 ministers. 63 will be out of compliance on Boundary Training by December 31st.

Churches in need and ministers in need are part of the Great Resignation. Threshold Coaches are trained through the Center for Progressive Renewal are assisting with this problem.

We are working to restore COM D and COM C. There are two churches seeking information. One, a new ministry in Benicia, and another a Lutheran Church exploring possibilities.

On Finances, the Capital Campaign Fund 50% check has been sent to the Pension Boards.

MOTION: Move the \$37,425 Capital Campaign Fund portion from operating funds to United Church Funds by Jeannie Hobson, 2nd Barb Colliander, Passed unanimously.

The Our Churches Wider Ministry [OCWM] database has been corrected and updated from 2021. We should confirm amounts with churches when calling. The office is working on transaction support for the finances.
